## European Championship & European Team Championship

### Prerequisites for selection in the Swiss Golf National Team 50+ Women & Men

The National Team 50+ includes a limited number of players selected according to the following criteria:

- Swiss nationality
- 50 years or over as of 0.00 hrs on Day 1 of the European Seniors Championship
- Good spirit, motivation and commitment
- Top players in the Swiss Golf Order of Merit 50+ (\*)
- Good Fitness level
- Participation in the Swiss Golf Open 50+
- Participation in individual events in the Swiss Golf Calendar
- Participation in SSLGA/ ASGS events of 2 days or more
- Participation in International tournaments 50+ (EGA Calendar)
- Participation in training camp(s) organized by the National Captain

(\*) Order of Merit (OM)

### Selection criteria for the European Individual Championship 50+ Women & Men

#### Procedure

Players interested in participating in the European Individual Seniors Championship have to sign up directly on the [EGA website](#). The EGA determines the number of participants per Nation and communicates it to Swiss Golf a few days prior the European Championship.

The National Captain 50+, together with the Swiss Golf Sport Commission will select the players to represent Switzerland.

#### Swiss Golf equipment

Only members of the National Team 50+ receive Swiss Golf equipment to be worn during the event and the practice days.

### Expenses

Only members of the National Team 50+ will be refunded.

Swiss Golf reimburses the registration fee and supports National Team members' with a max amount of CHF 1'500 for players participating in the European Individual Championship played abroad and CHF 600 if the event is played in Switzerland. For reimbursement, players must send the invoice with receipts to Swiss Golf.

Players are responsible for their bookings (accommodation & transportation).

## **Selection criteria for the European Team Championship 50+ Women & Men**

### Procedure

Players need to be suitable to play in a Team and will be selected as follows:

- Top 2 players in the Order of Merit 50+
- 4 Wild Cards (Captain's Pick, approval of the Swiss Golf Sport Commission)

The selection will be communicated no later than **July 15, 2024**.

### Swiss Golf equipment

Selected players receive Swiss Golf equipment to wear during the event and the practice days. No additional equipment with the Swiss Golf logo may be produced.

### Expenses

The National Captain, in collaboration with the Swiss Golf office, is responsible for all reservations. The National Captain takes care of the food and drink expenses during the week.

Swiss Golf will pay/reimburse following costs on presentation of an invoice with receipts:

- Team Registration Fee
- National Captain costs
- Travel by plane (economy class, booked by Swiss Golf). If players travel by train or private car, expenses will be refund to maximum of the cost of the economy flight
- Hotel accommodation (booked by Swiss Golf)
- Meals according to "expenses guidelines"
- Transfers on site (only if they are not organized by EGA)

Personal expenses, such as, but not limited to: domestic transfers, domestic accommodation, mini-bar, alcohol, caddies, won't be refunded.
